## THE ART

Morgan's mom designed the labels for City Limits. She loved the idea of using buildings or landscapes that everyone sees but "don't see". The familiar becomes almost unnoticed, yet, if anything was suddenly gone, the loss would be both physically and emotionally felt. Our inspiration behind The Citizen label is the Bread of Life Mission in Pioneer Square. It's an iconic Seattle institution in the middle of the city's oldest neighborhood that gives back to those in need. In short, it is a very good citizen.
